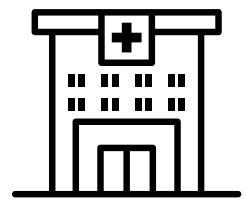

Radiation oncologists work as part of a treatment team in hospitals, cancer treatment centers and academic research facilities.

Together, these teams treat more than one million cancer patients in the U.S. each year.
