

ARRO Global Health Scholars

Eligibility and Application Requirements

- In order to be eligible as an applicant, the resident must obtain a written Letter of Support from their program director. This letter must indicate that the residency program supports and approves time away to the Destination Program, Clinic or Institution as well as to the following ASTRO Annual Meeting.
- A Statement of Intent must be completed by a sponsor, faculty or staff member of the Destination Program, Clinic or Institution.
- The Destination Clinic must be an established clinic and be fully operational. Applications for projects to visit new clinics, or clinics in process of being built, will not be considered.
- All projects must be completed in one city. Projects that include working with multiple institutions in one city will be evaluated on an individual basis.
- The project must be completed in four to six contiguous weeks in the same city.
- The scholar must travel as a resident or within six months of residency completion.
- Expected travel date must be included in the application.
- Clear goals, objectives and descriptions of how time will be organized during the project must be included in the application.
- Due to potential travel restrictions imposed by the COVID-19 pandemic, applications for projects that include telehealth as a component of their project will be considered.

Requirements for Award Recipients:

- Grant will be awarded upon completion of project via reimbursement of travel expenses. Awardee must submit receipts and a detailed account of all travel expenses incurred for the entire project. A template for submitting expenses will be provided.
- Travel plans must be confirmed (itinerary set, but tickets do NOT have to be purchased) by no later than December 31. A detailed plan should be submitted to ARRO@astro.org.
- Award recipients will be required to complete a short evaluation. An evaluation will also be required by the host mentor at the time of project completion.
- Recipients will provide photos of their experience and agree to be interviewed about their experience for various ASTRO and ARRO publications.
- Recipients MUST attend the following year's ASTRO Annual Meeting and present their experience at the ARRO Career Seminar, ARRO Luncheon or other ASTRO workshops. The venue will be decided by the ARRO Executive Committee based on time and space availability.
- Awardees must sign a waiver releasing ASTRO and ARRO of any liability or responsibility related to or in conjunction with their travel and stay.
- Failure to comply with program requirements may be subject to award revocation at the discretion of the ARRO Global Health Initiative.
