Original research abstracts will be selected for late-breaking presentations at the 2020 ASTRO Annual Meeting based on scientific merit, timeliness and interest to ASTRO's members and attendees. Abstracts may be submitted from commercial entities. If accepted, the abstract must be presented by a co-author with no relevant financial relationship or any commercial interest. Visit the <u>Annual Meeting Abstracts page</u> to get more details on submission requirements. The submission site is now open and will close on Sunday, August 9, 2020, at 11:59 p.m. Pacific time. The Plenary and Clinical Trials sessions will be prerecorded and available onDemand after they are released during the meeting. We encourage exhibitors who have original research to submit a late-breaking abstract for consideration.
