#### **SESSION TYPES KEY:**

- Education Sessions (EDU) Evidence-based sessions focused on what we know and what we are currently doing; standard of care.
- Oral Scientific Sessions (SS) Ten-minute abstract presentations with Q&A, grouped by track and often summarized by a discussant.
- Panel Sessions Moderated discussions led by expert panelists on current topics in an interactive format.
- Poster Q&A Sessions (PQA) Posters grouped by track. Authors have five minutes for individual poster presentations and three minutes for Q&A followed by open Q&A.
- Quick Pitch Sessions (QP) Oral scientific presentation sessions formatted with an introduction by the moderator and short presentations by abstract presenters followed by a moderated Q&A period.
- Science Highlights Sessions (SH) Overview of four to six of the most clinically relevant abstracts within each track presented by an expert discussant.
- Storytelling Sessions (ST) Members, patients and experts in the field share their experiences through compelling stories; attendees are invited to interact with speakers in a more personal way.
- Master Classes Deep dives into specific topics. (Ticket required for admission.)
