Dr Eric Whitman received his medical degree from Pennsylvania State University College of Medicine in Hershey. He completed his internship and residency in surgery at Milton S. Hershey Medical Center, where he was also a Chief Resident. He was a postdoctoral research fellow in general and vascular surgery at the Pennsylvania State University College of Medicine, and he was a senior staff fellow in the surgical metabolism section at the National Cancer Institute, National Institutes of Health, in Bethesda, MD.

Dr Whitman is the Medical Director of the Atlantic Health System Cancer Care and the Director of the Atlantic Melanoma Center, both in Morristown, NJ, and a clinical assistant professor of surgery at the F. Edward Hebert School of Medicine Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences in Bethesda, MD.

He is a prolific author, with many articles in peer-reviewed journals, as well as being an ad hoc reviewer for *Surgery*, *The Cancer Journal*, *Surgical Oncology*, *Journal of Clinical Dermatology*, and *Cancer*. He is the first editor for the book *Handbook of Radioguided Surgery*. He is actively involved in research, with many ongoing studies, and has given numerous presentations at professional congresses and meetings.

Dr Whitman is a member of professional organizations and is a fellow of the American College of Surgeons and founding member of the International Sentinel Node Society. He has received many honors and awards for his work.
